*Nice nose with a hint of violets and plenty of good cherry fruit. Lots of green apple characteristics on the palate*

*One of the few California Chardonnays that behaves like a Grand Cru Chablis. Exhibits a sleek edge as well as loads of lemon butter, green apple and white currant characteristics, laser-like precision, superb acidity and surprising intensity as well as richness*

**Guerila (Vipava, Slovenia) 2018** **Biodynamic**  
**Zelen** **37.50**  
*Light green colour with yellow hues, brilliant. Strongly expressed varietal characteristics. An aroma of Mediterranean herbs - bay, rosemary, thyme – combined with fruity and floral notes. A delicate, mineral wine with just the right balance of freshness and smoothness*

**Montirius Le Domaine, Mineral Vacqueyras (Rhone, France) 2015**  
**Bourboulenc, Roussanne & Grenache Blanc** **46.50**  
*A unique White with 50% of Bourboulenc dominating the blend and equal proportion of Grenache Blanc and Roussanne; Pure varietal expression not marked by oak! floral and herbaceous with aromas and flavours of yellow apple, pear and honeysuckle Medium bodied with distinct saltiness and refreshing*

**Remelluri Blanco (Rioja, Spain) 2015** **Organic**  
**Selection of 9 local varieties** **98.50**  
*Unique blend of nine different varieties (without Viura!!!) reflecting character of the place vineyards with clay, calcareous soil with notes of acacia, honey blossom and orange peel, the palate is surprisingly fresh with lively acidity, chalky mineral touch and creamy finish*

**Riesling Trocken, Fritz Haag (Mosel, Germany) 2017**

**Riesling**

*A truly unique and refreshing wine, this wine has delicate floral aromas on the nose and hints of fresh green apples, white currants and citrus on the palate. It is round and mellow, with a clean, long lasting finish*

**Vinuva, Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC, Italy 2017**

**Montepulciano d'Abruzzo**

**Organic**

**6.50 / 27.50**

*Intense ruby in colour with aromas of red fruits. Medium bodied with delicate tannins. Notes of ripe cherry and blackberry on the palate*

**Pinot Noir, Beaumas, Pays d'Oc (Languedoc, France) 2017**

**Pinot Noir**

**7.25 / 28.50**

*An attractive Pinot Noir, with persistent aromas of red berries and soft spices and a silky palate of strawberries, red cherries and redcurrants*

**Cotes Du Rhone Belleruche, M.Chapoutier (Rhône, France) 2017**

**Grenache & Syrah**

**7.50 / 29.50**

*Deep garnet red. Intense aromas of blackcurrant & raspberry notes. Juicy, powerful and fruity on the palate, with silky and delicate tannins*

Smooth, firm tannins plus more vanilla, chocolate and plenty of leather lead into the long, dry finish which also features lots of lingering oaky spice and even a bit of minerality*

*Intense and voluminous, yet elegant and polished, this wine offers dark cherries and dry spices on the nose and a fresh and enlivening palate, with sour red cherries, dense fruit and a velvety smooth finish*

**Carignana de Familongue (Languedoc, France) 2016**

**Carignan**

**7.50 / 29.50**

*Aromas of wild berries, black olive and Mediterranean herbs (thyme and rosemary) The palate is concentrated and fleshy with flavours of stewed black fruits, balanced out by lively acidity and typical for Carignan balsamic notes of menthol*

**Bibi Graetz It's a Game (Tuscany, Italy) 2016** **Organic**  
**Cabernet, Merlot, Syrah & Sangiovese** **13.50 / 50.50**  
*Bibi Graetz, which begins with the spicy and vegetal scents of Cabernet and Syrah and ends with the softness of Merlot. A modern, plush, full-framed red with punchy acidity that keeps the palate fresh and classy.*

**Tullio, Roberto Colombi (Piedmont, Italy) 2016** **35**  
**Barbera**  
*A medium-bodied wine driven by lively acidity, cherry and tobacco flavours. This wine is made from very old vines and the only best vintages are released to market. It has excellent drinkability and complexity.*

**Zorzal Eggo Bonaparte (Mendoza, Argentina) 2016** **47**  
**Bonarda 100%**  
*It is juicy, fresh and approachable with notes of black cherry, raspberry and subtle earthiness with fine tannins, a plush red berry fruit profile and floral highlights. A midweek winner.*

**Tignanello Marchesi Antinori Tignanello (Tuscany, IGP Italy) 2015** **135**  
**Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot & Cabernet Franc**  
*An intense ruby red in colour, the wine's nose shows ripe red fruit along with sustained sensations of vanilla and spices. The palate is ample and enveloping, balanced and vigorous with soft and silky tannins and the finish and aftertaste and long and persistent*

**Almansa Albhra, Envinata (La Mancha, Spain) 2017** **Organic**  
**Alicante Bouschet** **37**  
*Fragrant, pure and full of flavour but most of all true to its origin and terroir. Natural wine at its best, without compromise on flavour and quality! Natural wine and vegan friendly.*

**Les Vignerons Parisiens Haussmann 2016 (Rhône, France)** **46.50**  
**100% Syrah**  
*Dark Cherry red smoky with a slight reductive character. Savoury fruit combined with some sweet oak-spice. Fresh and dense yet still elegant.*

**Sequoia Grove (Napa Valley, USA) 2015** **90**  
**Cabernet Sauvignon**  
*Dark black in colour, the nose gives an immediate aroma of dark, smoky chocolate, leading into ripe blackberries and sweet cherries with notes of clove & vanilla. The palate is smooth and rich with ripe, developed tannins giving the wine a full arc in the mouth and giving flavours of blackberry and a hint of smoky, sweet oak.*

**Chateau Le Puy, Emilien 2015, (Cotes de Francs, France)** **Biodynamic**  
**Malbec, Merlot & Cab Franc** **74.50**  
*A fruity nose with ripe red fruit aromas dominated by blackcurrant and redcurrant and toasted almond notes. A precise and full-bodied wine with velvety tannins*

**Mas Coutelou Flambadou (Languedoc-Roussillon, France) 2017** **Organic**  
**Carignan** **51**  
*A pure Carignan and extremely attractive - it has a bright ruby/plum colour, a heady scent of vibrant dark fruits and spice and is very delicious and easy to enjoy.*

**Barolo, Camilla, Bruna Grimaldi (Piedmont, Italy) 2014**  
**Nebbiolo** **68**  
*This wine has pleasant and delicate aromas, with a complex yet well-balanced palate, enlivened by an attractive acidity. It has excellent depth and well integrated tannins that linger.*

**Catalpa, Bodegas Atamisque (Mendoza, Argentina) 2017**  
**Malbec** **41**  
*A classic Malbec, with strong character, real depth of flavour and a deep ruby-red hue. With hints of raspberries on the nose, this wine has an intense, well-developed and complex palate of dark fruits and herbs with a velvety smooth finish.*

**Monetou-Salon Les Bornés Rouge, Henry Pelle (Loire, France) 2015** **Natural**  
**Pinot Noir** **47**  
*A mixture of several Kimmeridgian marl parcels from Menetou-Salon. A pleasurably indulgent fruity wine with good body.*

**"Twelve Volts" - 4 Kilos, Vinicola, 2017 (Mallorca, Spain)** **Organic**  
**Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Merlot** **56.50**  
*Don't let the region Mallorca put you off this amazing wine. The people behind 4 kilos are excellent wine makers, this offers sweetly ripe, cinnamon tinged cherry aromas and rich fruit flavours mingled with a creamy texture, and a mellow sweetness.*

**Chateau La Peyere, Haut Medoc Bordeaux (France) 2013**  
**Merlot, Petit Verdo & Carbernet Sauvignon** **42.50**  
*Nice Ruby in colour, balanced and well-rounded on the palate with notes of cassis and cherries with firm tannins.*

**Parnanio, Cantina Sampietrana (Puglia, Italy) 2018** **Organic**  
**Negroamaro** **44.50**  
*A full-throttle organic negroamaro boasting notes of rich, ripe black cherry and damson, grilled herbs, smoke and rosemary*

**Les Vignerons Parisiens Haussmann (Rhône, France) 2016**

**Merlot**

**54**

*Medium deep ruby red with a purple hue. The palate is soft and supple with medium weight, floral red fruit, cassis and a young fresh acidity, polished tannin a slight hint of oak and quite a long finish.*

**Chateau Musar, Gaston Hochar (Bekaa Valley, Lebanon) 2011**

**Cinsault & Carignan**

**85.50**

*This year is a dark blood red colour with a rich, fragrant fruit nose; mulberries, black cherries, plums with a hint of mocha. The palate is very intense and concentrated, it's full of volume and characterised by forest and black fruits with elegant spice. The tannins are soft and juicy and it has a lengthy finish*

**Hermitage, Domaine des Tourettes, Delas Freres (Rhône, France) 2013**

**Syrah 100%**

**120**

*The colour shows brilliant, deep red hues. The nose is powerful and complex, expressing blackberries, spices and leather. On the palate, "Domaine des Tourettes" is firm but silky, with a tightly-knit tannic structure*

**Rioja Roda Sela (Rioja, Spain) 2015**

**Tempranillo, Garnacha & Graciano**

**45.50**

*A medium bodied and perfectly structured wine with vibrant red cherries on the nose, it has a fine, silky palate and soft integrated tannins which give it a highly polished and refreshing roundness.*

**St Nicolas de Bourgueils, Des Quarterons (Loire, France) 2015**

**Biodynamic**

**Cabernet Franc 100%**

*Initially subtle hints of violet which can be detected among the blueberry and stewed blackcurrant notes. It then softens without losing any of its assertive character.*

*Elegant, rich, and lively attack, lovely flavours of black berries and red fruits, mellow tannins, and a long spicy finish.*

#### **Blend of Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, and Tinta Amarela.**

*Dark red in colour it is fresh, young and fruity with aroma of dark fruits. Fantastic Port with great character and well balanced*

#### **Sauternes, Chateau Barbier (Bordeaux, France) 37cl 2015**

#### **Sauvignon Blanc & Semillion**

**7.00 / 35.50**

*Gold with amber hints, elegant, complex nose offering notes of quince, acacia and pineapple. A gourmet palate with delicate flavours of apricot and honey. A great accompaniment to foie gras.*

## SHERRY

### **Manzanilla, Fernando de Castilla N/V (Jerez, Spain) 37cl**

**6.50 / 25.50**

*Pale coloured, darker than a normal Fino as it has not been carbon filtered.*

*Yeasty aroma with apples and almonds; intensely nutty, savoury palate with fresh bread and salty tang. Dry with a tangy twist.*

**Organic wines** are made from grapes grown in accordance with principles of organic farming, which typically excludes the use of artificial chemical fertilizers, pesticides, fungicides and herbicides.

*Said to aid avoiding hangovers, find out for yourself !*

**Biodynamic wines** are wines made employing biodynamic methods both to grow the fruit and during the post-harvest processing. Biodynamic wine production uses organic farming methods while also employing soil supplements, following a planting calendar that depends upon astronomical configurations.
